#### Lake Hermann Restoration is

necessary to enhance our water-front programs such as fishing and canoeing for generations to come. Restoration needs include building a new retaining wall and removal of invasive plant species.

Shooting Ranges need a major berm renovation and better equipment for use by the thousands of Scouts who visit our camp each year.

#### Staff Cabin Enhancements have

already begun thanks to generous donations and volunteers. The cabins can now house up to 12 staff during programs and include bunkbeds, a bathroom and 2 showers, a kitchenette, and outdoor gathering area. We have one more cabin to repair!

rebuilt to provide an element of high adventure. We lost ours to old age and weather.

## Amphitheater & Chapel Projects

will create ample seating and audio to enhance outdoor programs for campers. The project will also increase the capacity of the seating so the entire camp can enjoy campfires, skits, songs, and presentations.

#### Leader's Lodge is a silent witness to our

heritage. It remains one of the central points of camp providing a headquarters for checkins and registration, and also a training hub for programs.
