

Camp Karankawa - Camp Welcome Letter & Check-In Procedures

Dear Campers,

Welcome to Camp Karankawa and thank you for camping with us this weekend.

To make your weekend stay with us memorable and enjoyable, below is some very helpful information. Please read through the information thoroughly.



DK Hopwood, Camp Ranger

Gates - Camp is located at 3249 FM 1459 Rd., Sweeny, TX 77480. The main entrance is on FM 1459. Please be sure you enter here. Other entrances are locked. Gates open at 6 p.m. on Fridays. Check-out by 11 a.m. on Sundays.

Campsites – Family/Unit campers - You may choose any open campsite on the map. Out-of-Council Units - The Camp Ranger will email you a camp location before your reservation dates.

Directions to Campsites - Upon entering the main entrance, you will pass the Ranger House on the right, continue through the red main gate. Travel on to the Tee in the road. (Ranger Road & Lodge Road.)

Cub Campsites – At the tee, continue straight and as you near the garbage dumpster, the parking area is on your left.

Troop Campsites – At the tee, turn right onto Lodge Road. Drive to Scout Road (1/4 mile), and turn right. Drive to the troop parking lot.

Speed Limit - The speed limit at camp is 10 mph (maximum).

Hauling Gear - There are wagons to haul gear from the parking lot to your campsites. (Please return them after each use.)

Bathhouses - The Bathhouse at the Troop and Cub campsites are individual rooms with a flush toilet, sink and shower with hot water. Toilet Paper is supplied. Towels, soap, etc. are not provided.

Fires & Firewood - Fires are only permitted in the provided fire rings at campsites. Firewood is complimentary at campsites. You may also use wood, that is laying on the ground only, for your fires.

Picnic Tables - There are a few picnic tables for use at each camp site.

Prohibited areas – Chained or taped off areas are to be respected at all times for your safety. Only the Camp Ranger (white truck or ranger UTV) is allowed on non-paved roads.

Refrigeration - Refrigeration is not available at camp.

Wildlife - Snakes (Copperheads, Corral, and Moccasins) and alligators are active in camp. Be aware. Do not approach or bother animals.

Water - Make sure everyone has a water bottle and is staying hydrated.

Camp Karankawa Family Camping Requirements

(For Use During Recreational Family Camping only.)

Family Campers are required to:

1. At least one youth **MUST BE A REGISTERED MEMBER** of the Bay Area Council, Boy Scouts of America.
2. All adults **MUST HAVE CURRENT YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING** with a certification on file with the Council office.
3. Bring their own food, tents and all needed supplies, including a first-aid kit.
4. Leave the camp area in the same condition as when they arrived.
5. Check in and check out with the Camp Ranger.
6. Behave in a Scout-like manner while on camp property.
7. Follow all directions of the Camp Ranger.
8. Wear close-toed shoes.
9. Understand that this is a rustic, nature area with various wildlife, including poisonous snakes, spiders, bobcats, and alligators.
10. Supervise children at all times.
11. Only use existing fire rings. Keep your fire small. Make sure it is out and cold before you leave.

Camp Karankawa will provide:

1. A designated camping area.
2. Fire ring for campfires.
3. Wood for campfires.
4. An on-property Camp Ranger in case of emergencies and check in/check out.

**You will not be at camp alone. When walking around camp, masks & social distancing required during known health crisis.*

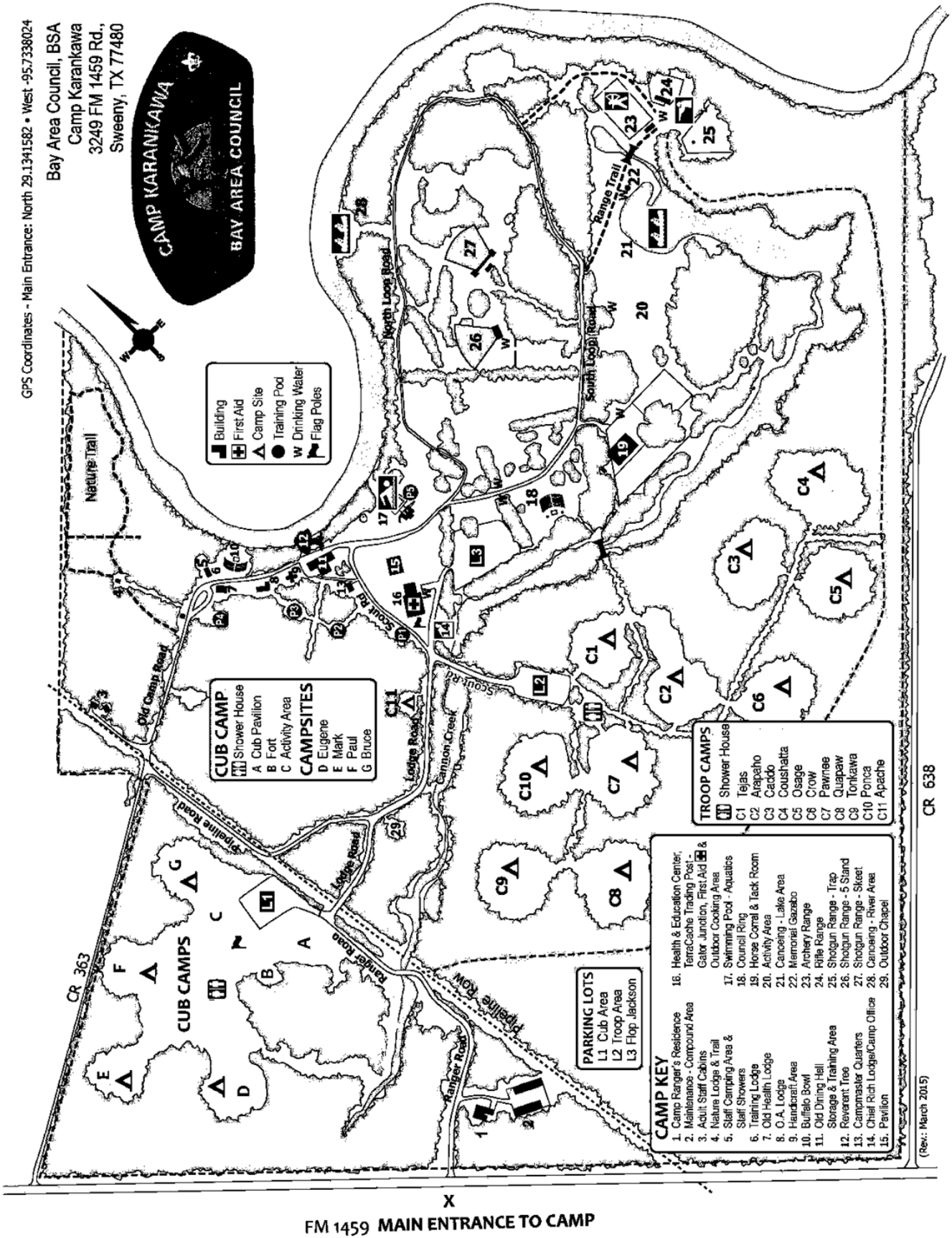
