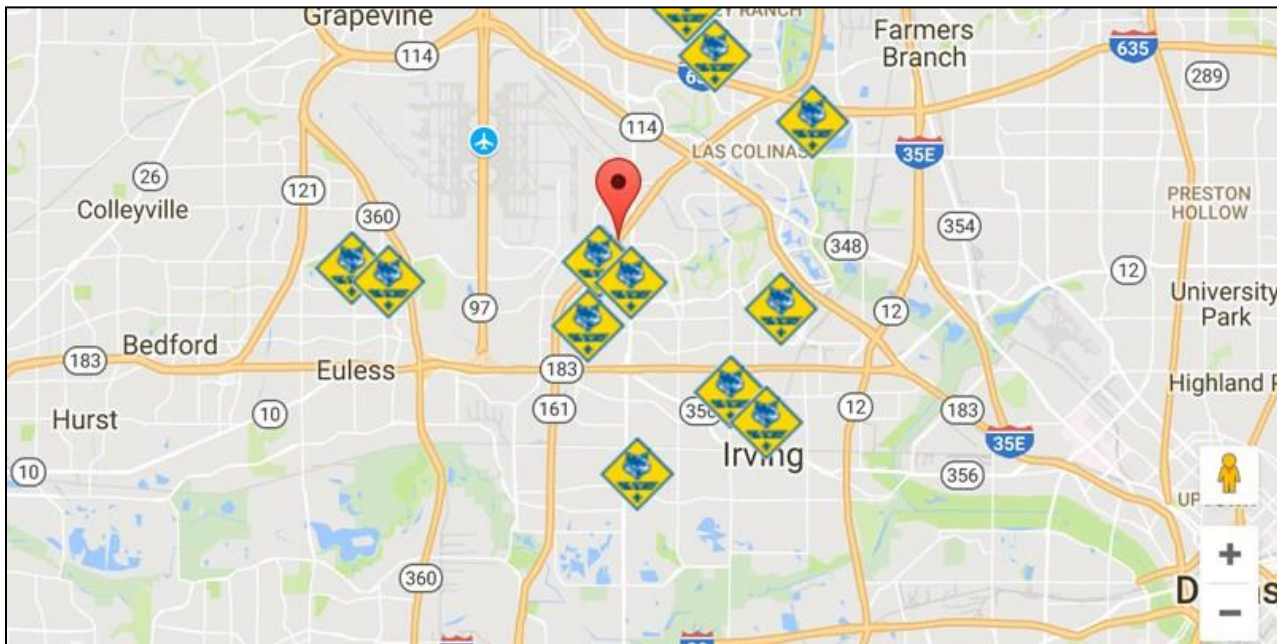


Update BeAScout.org with Family Scouting



Make it easy for parents to find out which units will accept girls in the Fall. Have your Charter Organization Representative, Cubmaster, or Committee Chair update beascout.org.

1. Log on to my.scouting.org.
2. Click on the “Menu” button on left hand side.
3. Under your Cub Scout Pack, click on “Organization Manager.”
4. Under “Organization Manager” click on “Settings” at the top of the page.
5. On the settings page, scroll to the bottom.
6. At the bottom there is a section called “Family Scouting,” fill this out and click “commit.”

You must commit to the following:

- Your Charter Organization Representative, Cubmaster, or Committee Chair must first update your unit pin on beascout.org.
- Commit to have trained leaders.
- Commit to having single-gender dens.
